Application for Appointment to the Altoona Public Library Board of Trustees



Providing quality library service to the patrons of the Altoona Public Library requires a working team consisting of a library director and a Library Board of Trustees who are well-informed and makes the necessary decisions for the well-being of the library. It is critical that each person appointed to the Library Board of Trustees be willing to perform the duties expected of them. "Library Trustee" is a voluntary appointment, and as such, no payment is offered for the position.

The Altoona Public Library Board of Trustees is composed of seven (7) trustees who are appointed by the Mayor of Altoona with approval by the City Council. The term of office for new trustees is three (3) years, at which time a trustee may be reappointed. If replacing a trustee who was unable to fulfill their three-year commitment, the appointee will serve out the remainder of the departing trustee's term, at which point they may be reappointed by the Mayor and City Council.

Prospective trustees must be aware of the following criteria, all of which will be considered when selecting an appointee to the Library Board of Trustees.

- 1. Commit the time necessary to carry out the duties of a trustee. This includes time to become, and remain, knowledgeable about public library issues, attend board meetings, and to carry out board assignments.
- 2. Be genuinely interested in public libraries and understand the importance of public libraries in meeting the educational, recreational, and informational needs of the community.
- 3. Understand the local community and its unique social and cultural needs and be willing to communicate those needs to the rest of the library board.
- 4. Be able to work as a team to achieve common goals.
- 5. Be open-minded, intellectually curious, and respectful of the opinions of others.
- 6. Have the courage and ability to plan creatively and direct the effective implementation of those plans.
- 7. Be able to understand and consider internal and external biases that would restrict or prevent equal access to library services and resources for all.
- 8. Be committed to providing services and resources that are diverse, equitable, and inclusive.

What Trustees Do

- Develop and approve library policies.
- Hire and evaluate the library director.
- Budget and financial planning for the library.
- Plan, implement, and complete library initiatives, which may include strategic and long-range planning, building improvements or expansion, and developing library service and program initiatives with consideration to the needs of the community.
- Advocate for the Altoona Public Library within the community, government, and media.
